Agreement to Foster and Temporary Release of Rescue Dog

I, the undersigned, agree in consideration of the release of the dog to me and for other good and valuable consideration (the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged) to:

- a) foster the dog, named _____ (hereinafter referred to as "the dog" from CSRBC Cocker Spaniel Rescue (hereinafter referred to as "CSRBC")).
- b) release, indemnify and save harmless the CSRBC, Carol J. Jackson and all employees, contractors and other representatives of CSRBC (collectively, the "Indemnified") from and against any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, penalties, fines, accounts, covenants, agreements, judgments, claims, demands and other liabilities whatsoever (collectively, "Claims") arising directly or indirectly out of or in any way relating to the fostering, placement, ownership, possession, temperament or harmful or injurious acts of the dog including, without limitation, Claims arising as the result of any personal injury to the undersigned or any other person or damage to property of the undersigned or any other person, it being the intention of the undersigned that the Indemnified will have no liability whatsoever in respect of the dog or its behaviour at any time after the dog has been released to the care and custody of the undersigned; and
- c) maintain at all times (whether through his or her home insurance policies or otherwise) such liability insurance as may be required by CSRBC to adequately protect CSRBC and the Indemnified from any Claims which may arise as the result of personal injury or damage to property caused by the dog. The undersigned further agrees that CSRBC, Carol J. Jackson and such other representatives of CSRBC as may be designated from time to time shall be added to any such policy as named insureds and that satisfactory evidence of the coverage required by this provision shall be delivered to CSRBC at its request from time to time.

I understand the fostering program of CSRBC and I have decided to become a foster. I will contact CSRBC concerning any and all problems associated with the rescue dog in my care. I agree to provide food, water and shelter for the dog while in my custody. I agree to provide emergency medical care if necessary, and will contact CSRBC as soon as possible to advise them of the circumstances. If the dog becomes lost, it is my responsibility to contact CSRBC immediately, and to contact the local shelter(s), put up signs in the immediate area, and canvas the area in the effort to locate the dog
